Our assessments are designed to measure whether a learner has met the requirements of a particular qualification. They are awarded on a pass / refer basis and are criterion-referenced. This means that everyone who takes an assessment and demonstrates that they meet the required standard are awarded a pass.
<p>Assessments</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Unit IG1 (replacing IGC1) includes an open book exam, which you can do from anywhere on any smart device. You will have 24 hours to access, complete and submit your paper starting from 11am (UK time) on the examination date. • Unit IG2 is assessed by a practical assessment, which is longer than the previous GC3 assessment. Learners will complete a risk assessment and develop an action plan for their workplace.
